



Ensure Only U. S. Citizens Can Register to Vote and Cast a Ballot



Current Situation: There is border crisis.

- Florida currently relies on new voter registrants to declare if they are a citizen or not – **Citizenship is not being verified!**
- **Millions of non-citizens could register to vote in Florida** because of lack of safeguards in Florida’s voter registration process in violation of state & federal laws.
- **Non-citizens** are regularly issued driver licenses, state ID, and social security numbers. They **can register to vote using these government issued ID or with No ID.**
- **Since 2020, over 1 million Florida driver licenses and state ID were issued to non-citizens.**
- **Over 8% of Florida’s voting age population are not U.S. citizens.**

Proposed Solution:

- **Require verification of citizenship** using all available means, including the use of the DMV database which classifies driver license and state ID holders as citizens, immigrants, or non-immigrants. **(SB1602)**
- **Provide additional tools for Supervisors of Elections to remove non-U. S. citizens** from our voter roll with due process **(SB1602)**
- **Prohibit knowingly soliciting non-citizens to register to vote** **(SB1602)**
- **Provide a citizenship designation on driver licenses and state ID which may be updated upon naturalization** **(HB1101 / SB1168)**
